Hi - I write to inform you that the Commission has received the decision by the independent delegate, Mr Geoffrey Nettle AC KC, appointed to reconsider the referrals from the Royal Commission into the Robodebt Scheme.

Mr Nettle has decided that each of the 6 referrals raises a corruption issue and that all 6 referrals should progress to corruption investigations under the *National Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2022* (Cth).

The Commission is making arrangements to ensure the impartial and fair investigation of the referrals, as it did with the appointment of Mr Nettle as Independent Delegate.

The Commissioner and Deputy Commissioners Rose and Gauntlett will not participate in the investigation.

We will shortly issue a media release announcing this which you will be able to view here.

There is no doubt this announcement will generate a high level of media interest and commentary on the Commission and our work once again.

I acknowledge this news may upset or frustrate some of you. And I understand you may have questions for us about the announcement or views you want to raise.

As always, I will remind you the dedicated channels we have in place to allow you to seek support or discuss openly about this and all matters that are affecting you.

#### This includes:

- The Anonymous feedback form
- Contact with your manager, General Manager, or the People team
- The Commission's free 24/7 EAP service.

I have also asked each General Manager to book in a meeting with you as soon as practicable, to provide a line of direct communication for you to ask questions or share how you are feeling and what you want more information on.

In the meantime, we will continue to progress the Commission's important work, and I will provide you with updates as soon as there is more I can share.
